According to the Florida Department of Commerce, Bureau of Labor Market Statistics:

The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Polk region was 5.5% in December 2025. This rate was 1.6% point greater than the region's year ago rate of 3.9%.



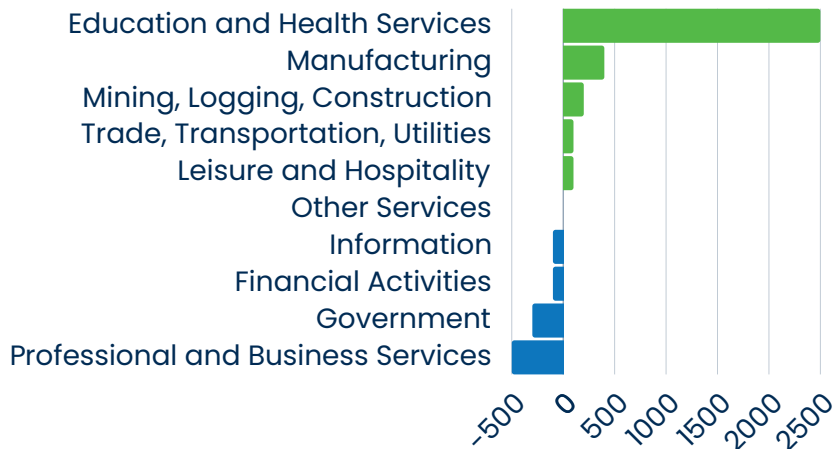
The region's December 2025 unemployment rate was 1.1% points above the state rate of 4.4%. The labor force was 361,713, up 3,320 (+0.9%) over the year. There were 19,946 unemployed residents in the Polk County region.

LABOR MARKET ANALYSIS

In December 2025, nonagricultural employment in the Lakeland-Winter Haven MSA was 283,500, an increase of 2,300 jobs (+0.8%) over the year.

The Education and Health Services industry led job growth in the region, adding 2,500 jobs over the year. With a 5.9% increase, outpacing statewide growth, this sector continues to be a key economic driver, reflecting the area's expanding healthcare facilities and ongoing demand for educational services.

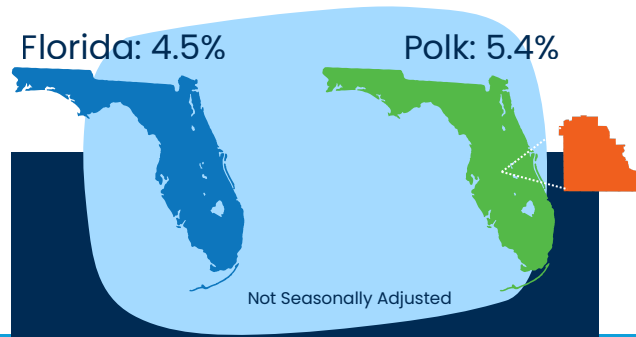
