## According to the Florida Department of Commerce, Bureau of Labor Market Statistics:

The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Polk region was 5% in July 2025. This rate was 0.2% point greater than the region's year ago rate of 4.8%.



The region's July 2025 unemployment rate was 0.9% points above the state rate of 4.1%. The labor force was 362,120, up 2,899 (+0.8%) over the year. There were 18,239 unemployed residents in the Polk County region.


#### LABOR MARKET ANALYSIS

In July 2025, nonagricultural employment in the Lakeland-Winter Haven MSA was 275,500, an increase of 5,200 jobs (+1.9%) over the year.

The Education and Health Services industry led job growth in the region, adding 2,100 jobs over the year. With a 5.1% increase, outpacing statewide growth, this sector continues to be a key economic driver, reflecting the area's expanding healthcare facilities and ongoing demand for educational services.
