

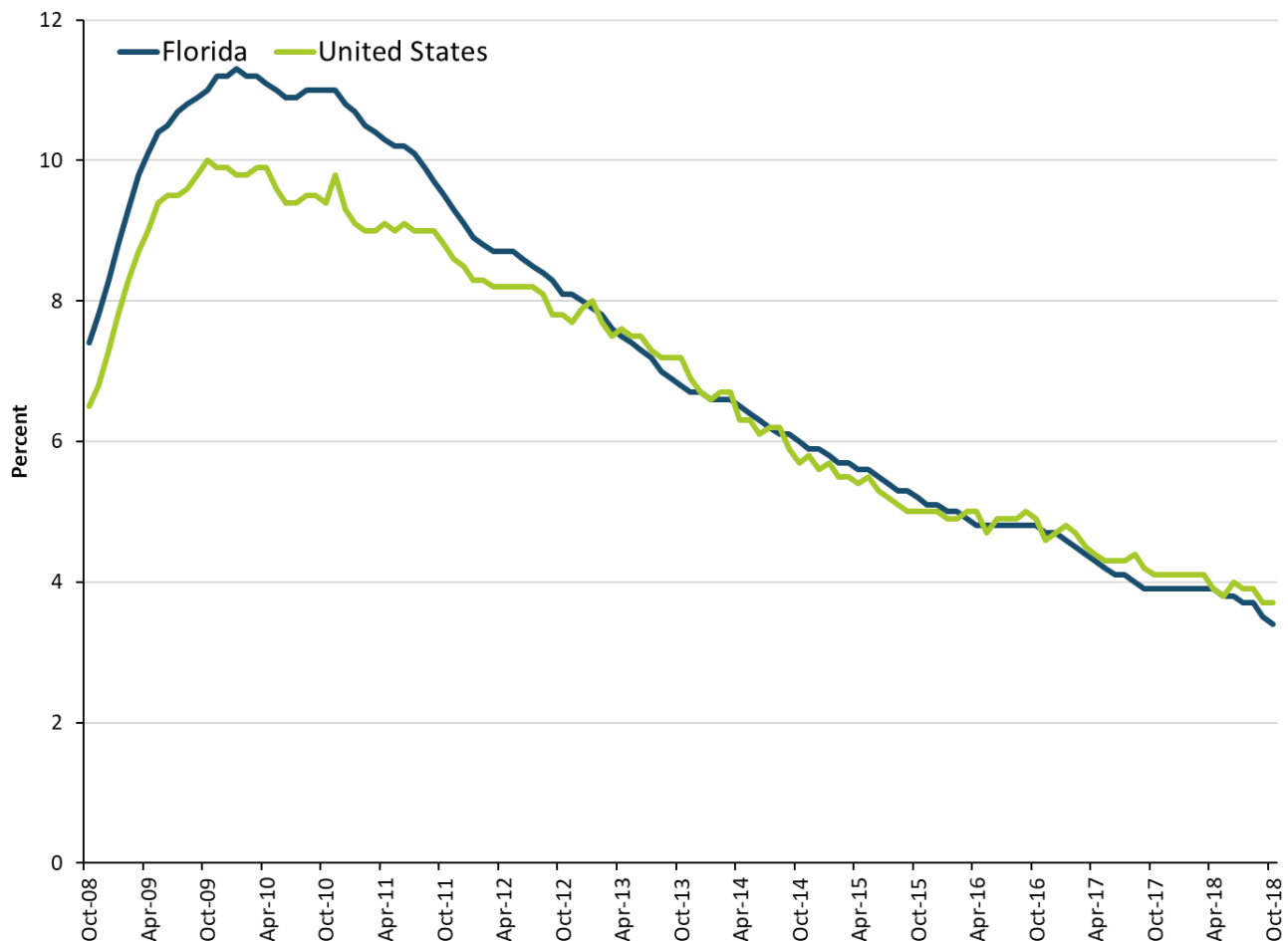

Florida's October Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in October 2018, down 0.1 percentage point from the September 2018 rate, and down 0.5 percentage point from a year ago. There were 345,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,246,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 3.7 percent in October.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 8,847,300 in October 2018, an increase of 17,800 jobs (+0.2 percent) over the month. The state gained 232,600 jobs over the year, an increase of 2.7 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.7 percent over the year. With the exception of September 2017, Florida's over-the-year job growth rate had exceeded the nation's rate since May 2012.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- The number of jobs in Florida was 8,847,300 in October 2018, up 232,600 jobs compared to a year ago. The industry gaining the most jobs was education and health services (+51,300 jobs, +4.0 percent).
- Other industries gaining jobs over the year included leisure and hospitality (+51,100 jobs, +4.2 percent); construction (+43,400 jobs, +8.5 percent); professional and business services (+30,100 jobs, +2.3 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+25,300 jobs, +1.4 percent); financial activities (+16,700 jobs, +2.9 percent); manufacturing (+11,800 jobs, +3.2 percent); other services (+11,200 jobs, +3.2 percent); and information (+400 jobs, +0.3 percent)
- The one industry losing jobs was government (-8,900 jobs, -0.8 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2018, Monroe County and Okaloosa County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.4 percent each); followed by St. Johns County, Walton County and Wakulla County (2.5 percent each).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (5.4 percent) in Florida in October 2018, followed by Hardee County (4.5 percent); and Citrus County and Sumter County (4.3 percent each).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2018, 23 out of 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+55,400 jobs, +4.4 percent), Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+29,100 jobs, +2.5 percent), and Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+29,100 jobs, +2.2 percent).
- Panama City was the only metro area to experience an over-the-year job loss in October 2018 (-100 jobs, -0.1 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
